Moebius Shawlette with Ruffles and Scallops



Materials: 1 hank Colinette *Tagliatelle* (90% wool, 10% nylon, 160 yards, color Monet)

1 hank Fiesta *La Luz* (100% silk, 210 yards, color Vintage Rose
US Size 15 and 10.5 (10 and 6.5mm) circular 60" needle

Notes:

Garter stitch: in Moebius, this is knit one row, purl one row.

Kfbfbf: Knit into the front, back, front, back, front of the same stitch (making 5 sts out of 1). If you prefer, you can alternately knit and purl into the same stitch until you have achieved the same result, i.e. 5 sts.

Directions: Moebius cast on 80 sts with #15 needle. Place marker

and join. Work in garter stitch (knit one row, purl one row in this case) until you have used up all the *Tagliatelle*. Switch to *La Luz* and the #10.5 needle, work as follows:

Round 1: Knit into the front and back of every stitch

Round 2: Purl

Round 3: Knit into the front and back of every stitch

Round 4: Purl

Round 5: *Kfbfbf, K5*

Round 6: Bind off.

If you want a less ruffy ruffle, work round 3 as a plain knit round. Note: your stitches may not work out exactly to 5 at the end. This is ok, just fudge it. Pour yourself a cup of coffee or tea before you do the bind off - it will take you a while... When you're done, weave in an end or two and wear with pride.
